System Integration Document for Avalara AvaTax

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1.0 Connector Overview

The Avalara for Adobe Commerce connector provides rapid integration for Adobe Commerce implementations. The extension is open-sourced package that can easily integrate into any Adobe Commerce instance. This extension can be configured in the Adobe Commerce Administrator and contain all the elements necessary to perform a successful implementation of AvaTax **Tax Calculation**, **Address Validation**, **Tax Certificate**, **VAT** and **Cross-Border** services.

2.0 Configuration

To configure the Avalara for Adobe Commerce connector, navigate to Admin > Stores > AvaTax Configuration > Sales Tax.

2.1. Extension Mode

To configure the Extension Mode for the Avalara for Adobe Commerce connector, navigate to Admin > Stores > AvaTax Configuration > Extension Mode.

To configure address validation for the Avalara for Adobe Commerce connector, navigate to Admin > Stores > AvaTax Configuration > Address Validation.

To configure VAT for the Avalara for Adobe Commerce connector, navigate to Admin > Stores > AvaTax Configuration > VAT.

To configure the cross-border settings for the Avalara for Adobe Commerce connector, navigate to Admin > Stores > AvaTax Configuration > Cross-Border.
